On 22 March 1999, Cyclone Vance bore down on Exmouth. The storm unleashed torrential rain and winds of up to 267km per hour; the strongest ever recorded on mainland Australia.

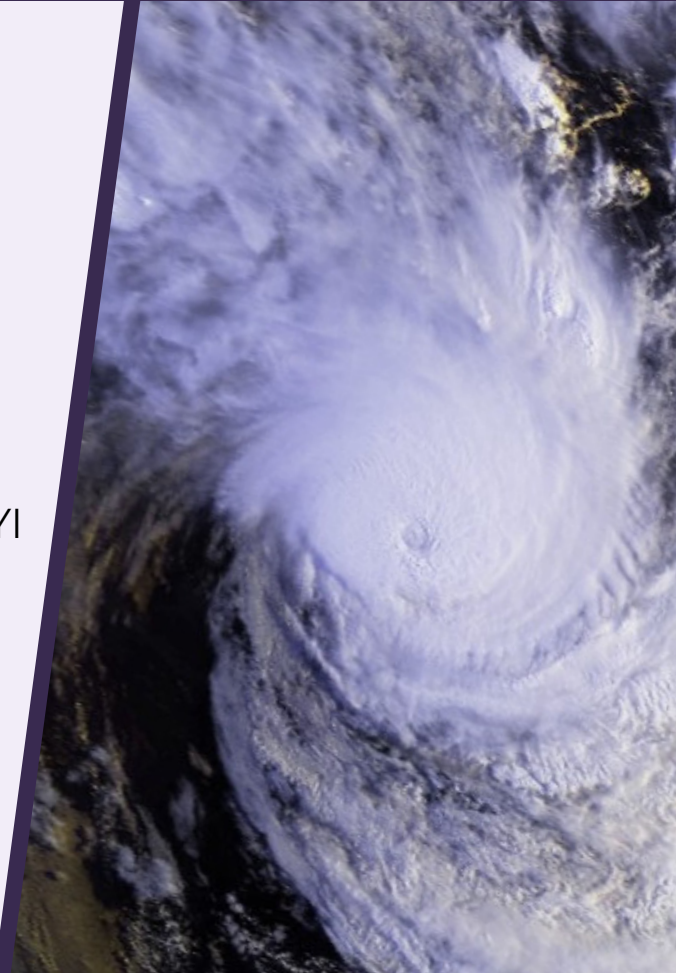
