ABOUT THIS COURSE

Would you like to be a part of a new public street art project in Exmouth? This project-based learning experience will give you the skills needed to create a stencil graffiti artwork mural at the iconic location of Town Beach.

The first part of this course will involve learning stencil street art skills for design and creation of two new murals to complement the existing mural at Town Beach (painted in 2001 by former CRTAFE students). The new artworks on the end walls of the ablution facility will be completed in time for the International Whale Shark Festival to be held in Exmouth at the end of May.

The second part of this course will involve creating your own personal artwork using stencil street art skills you've gained. Come along, join the fun and be a part of Exmouth's ongoing history.
